2019 Rules Changes

2019 has been an exciting and historic year for the game of golf and how the rules are enforced. The USGA and the R&A have made 31 rule changes with a focus on modernizing the game and improving pace of play. Please visit our [Rules Hub](#) to learn more about the New Rules of Golf. These changes took effect in January 2019.

Player Registration

Player Registration will take place on Thursday, May 30, starting at 4:30 p.m. at the practice area.

Inauguration Ceremony

Please join us for the inauguration ceremony on May 30, at 4:00 p.m. Snacks will be provided.

Age Verification

U.S. Kids Golf TPA will be verifying players' birthdates at Championship events. This is a one-time process for each player.

Pre-Verification: Players can submit an electronic passport copy or birth certificate copy to U.S. Kids Golf prior to the event to become a verified player. Documents can be emailed to tournaments@uskidsgolf.com

Caddie Bibs

Players that have already received a U.S. Kids Golf Tour México caddie bib should bring it with them to the 2019 U.S. Kids Golf Bajío Cup. Remaining players will receive a bib at Player Registration. The bib should be used for all future U.S. Kids Golf Tour México events.

Players that wish to order his/her last name on their caddie bib may do so by emailing your order to contacto@uskidsgolfmexico.com.mx. You will be able to pay and pick up your personalized caddie bib at the Player Registration. The last day to order your personalized caddie bib will be May 22. The cost is \$10 USD.

Dress Code

Only acceptable golf attire is permitted. PLAYERS AND CADDIES are prohibited from wearing shoes with metal spikes, short shorts, swimwear, denim of any kind, t-shirts, or tank tops. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Players and caddies not appropriately attired will not be permitted to participate.

REQUIRED DRESS AT THE GOLF COURSE:

- Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward
- Males must remove hat/visor while indoors
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times
- Girls' fitted shirts do not have to be tucked in, but should be an appropriate length

PROHIBITED DRESS AT THE GOLF COURSE:

- Tank tops, T-shirts
- Denim
- Shorts, skorts or skirts that are too short
- Cut-off shorts
- Gym shorts or pants

Proper attire is required at all times at the host facility. This includes practice rounds, Family Nights and Awards Ceremonies. Questionable attire will be reviewed by the Tournament Committee. Should a host golf course or resort have a stricter dress code, its policy will take precedence. Players and caddies in violation will not be allowed to tee off.

Care for the Course

U.S. Kids Golf México and Fundación Infantil de Golf is committed to keeping our host tournament sites in the best condition possible. During the round, we encourage players and caddies to fill or replace their divots, repair ball marks and dispose of trash properly. These simple things will keep the course in better condition and leave the host facility with a positive impression of junior golf and U.S. Kids Golf families. Thank you for helping make a positive impact on the golf course.

Carts

Due to the very limited availability of rental carts, U.S. Kids Golf Bajío Cup will give priority to spectators in the following categories:

- Physically challenged spectators (must have legal verification on hand)
- 60+ years old (must have valid ID)
- Pregnant women (must have a written doctor's note)
- Adults with a child 5 years old and younger

Drivers must be 18 years or older. Carts must remain on the cart path.

If eligible, please reserve your cart in the pro shop during player registration. Only two people are allowed in a standard golf cart, without exception. Keep in mind the Club Campestre de Aguascalientes is a very tight and easy to walk golf course. We guarantee you'll enjoy the stroll.

Cart Cost: \$25 USD 18 Holes; \$15 USD 9 Holes

Practice Rounds

A single practice round is included on Thursday, May 30. No additional practice rounds are allowed. It is mandatory to request a practice round tee time, as soon as possible, at this phone number (449) 9141157 Ext - 120 (please include: player's name, age group, preferred time). Threesomes are mandatory; minimum of a caddie per group.

Caddie Rate: 18 holes \$25 USD, 9 holes \$15 USD. Tip is not included.

During practice rounds, extra tee and approach shots are not permitted. Extra putting is allowed if it does not hold up play. Practice rounds should not exceed the expected tournament pace of play guidelines (4 hours, 40 minutes). Violation of this policy could be determined as a code of conduct violation by the golf course.

Driving Range

Practice balls at the driving range will be available at no cost from May 30-June 2.

Tee Times

Players will be paired randomly for the first round and by score for the final round, unless weather conditions prohibit this. Tee times for the first round will be posted on our U.S. Kids Golf Bajío Cup homepage, our official sites (<http://uskidsgolfmexico.com.mx> and <http://fundacioninfantiledegolf.com>), as well as in the reception area, registration area and the hotel by noon on Thursday, May 30.

Times for the final round will be posted approximately two hours after the completion of play for each age/gender division on our website and at the golf course. Players and parents are advised to look at pairings sheets personally to confirm tee times.

Award Ceremonies

The awards will be presented on Sunday shortly after each age group has finished and the scores are posted. The top five finishers in each age group will receive a medal. A schedule of awards ceremonies will be posted Friday morning and all ceremonies will be held at the restaurant in the clubhouse.

Demo Day

U.S. Kids Golf will be hosting a Demo Day on Friday, May 31. The Demo Day will be located at the Driving Range.

Priority Status

There are four levels of [Priority Status](#) that players may earn based on their order of finish at the U.S. Kids Golf Bajío Cup: Burgundy Status, Green Status, Orange Status and Blue Status. All players must meet the Scoring Requirement at the event in which he or she qualifies. This Priority Status is good for one year and covers all events that are played in that span.

The Priority Status earned from the Bajío Cup based on order of finish, is listed below.

Tournament rounds shortened due to weather, darkness, or other circumstances will not count towards the [scoring requirement](#).
