



### Putting it all Together: Plan, Setup, Play

In Levels 1 through 4 you learned the forms to plan, practice and play a putt. In this level, all of the Forms that you have learned will come together as you execute a putt from start to finish. Start the reviewing your forms on this Planning page.

#### Mark the Ball

Place a marker directly behind the ball. You may now pick up the ball to clean it. Replace the ball exactly on the spot from where it was removed. Pick up the marker.

#### Reading the Green: Two Point Read

“Squat behind the ball to read the slope of the putt. Then move to the lower side, about half-way between the ball and the hole to determine if the putt is uphill, downhill, or flat.”

#### Find the Target

Locate the spot where you will aim and set that as your target.

#### Practice Strokes

Practice strokes can be made beside the ball, behind the ball, or not at all.
