Player Registration*

Player Registration will take place on Thursday, December 13th, starting at 4:30 p.m. at the practice area. For a complete listing of Course Assignments by Age, please visit the Registration Information homepage.

Inauguration Ceremony

Please join us for the inauguration ceremony, December 13th, at 4:00 p.m. There will be games, and Mexican snacks.

Age Verification

U.S. Kids Golf will be verifying TPA player's birthdates at Championship events. This is a one-time process for each player.

Pre-Verification: Players can submit an electronic passport copy or birth certificate copy to U.S. Kids Golf prior to the event to become a verified player. Documents can be emailed to tournaments@uskidsgolf.com

Caddie Bibs

Players that have already received a US Kids Golf Tour México caddie bib should bring it with them to the 2018 Mexico City Championship. Remaining players will receive a bib at Player Registration. The bib should be used for all future U.S. Kids Golf Tour México events.

Players that wish to order his/her last name on their caddie bib may do so by emailing your order to contacto@uskidsgolfmexico.com.mx you will be able to pay and pick up your personalized caddie bib at the Player Registration. Cost \$10 US

Dress Code

Only acceptable golf attire is permitted. PLAYERS AND CADDIES are prohibited from wearing shoes with metal spikes, short shorts, swimwear, and denim of any kind, t-shirts, or tank tops. Shirts must be tucked in at all times. Players and caddies not appropriately attired will not be permitted to participate.

REQUIRED DRESS AT THE GOLF COURSE:

- Hats/visors must be worn with brim forward
- Males must remove hat/visor while indoors
- Shirts must be tucked in at all times

- Girls' fitted shirts do not have to be tucked in, but should be an appropriate length

PROHIBITED DRESS AT THE GOLF COURSE:

- Tank tops, T-shirts
- Denim
- Shorts, skorts or skirts that are too short
- Cut-off shorts
- Gym shorts or pants

Proper attire is required at all times at the host facility. This includes practice rounds, Family Nights and Awards Ceremonies. Questionable attire will be reviewed by the Tournament Committee. Should a host golf course or resort have a stricter dress code, its policy will take precedence. Players and caddies in violation will not be allowed to tee off.

Care for the Course

U.S. Kids Golf México and Fundación Infantil de Golf is committed to keeping our host tournament sites in the best condition possible. During the round, we encourage players and caddies to fill or replace their divots, repair ball marks and dispose of trash properly. These simple things will keep the course in better condition and leave the host facility with a positive impression of junior golf and U.S. Kids Golf families. Thank you for helping make a positive impact on the golf course.

Carts

Due to the very limited availability of rental carts, USKG Mexico City Championship will give priority to spectators in the following categories:

- Physically challenged spectators (must have legal verification on hand)
- Pregnant women (must have a written doctor 's note)
- Adults with a child 5 years old and younger
- 60+ years old (must have valid ID)

Please reserve, if eligible, during player registration. Only two people are allowed in a standard golf cart, without exception. Keep in mind the CCCM is a very tight and easy to walk golf course, we guarantee you 'll enjoy the stroll.

Cost \$ 700 pesos per round (\$35 USD)

Practice Rounds

A single practice round is included. No additional practice rounds are allowed. It is a mandatory to request a practice round tee time, as soon as possible, at uskids@cccmjuniorgolf.com (please include: player's name, age group, preferred time)

Under the following schedule:

- Local Players (AGVM): Monday, December 10th, to Wednesday, December 12th.
- Visiting players (México and abroad): Thursday 13th, 9:00 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

As the course will have member play leading to the MCC, during practice rounds, extra tee and approach shots are not permitted. Extra putting is allowed if it does not hold up play. Practice rounds should not exceed expected tournament pace of play guidelines (4 hours, 30 minutes). Violation of this policy could be determined as a code of conduct violation by the Golf course.

Driving Range

Practice balls at driving range will be available at no cost from December 14 thru 16.

Tee Times

Players will be paired randomly for the first round and by score for the final round, unless weather conditions prohibit this. Tee times for the first round will be posted on our Mexico City Championship homepage, and official sites

And in the reception, registration area and Hotels by noon on Thursday, December 13th. Times for the final round will be posted approximately two hours after the completion of play for each age/gender division on our website and at the golf course. Players and parents are advised to look at pairings sheets personally to assure accuracy of tee times.

Award Ceremonies

The awards will be presented shortly after each age group has finished and the scores are posted on Sunday. The top five finishers in each age group will receive a medal. A schedule of Awards Ceremonies will be posted Friday morning and all ceremonies will be held at the principal Restaurant of Club house.

Demo Day

U.S. Kids Golf will be hosting a Demo Day on Friday, December 14th. The Demo Day will be located at the Driving Range.

Priority Status

There are four levels of [Priority Status](#) that players may earn based on their order of finish at the USKG México City Championship: Burgundy Status, Green Status, Orange Status and Blue Status. All players must meet the Scoring Requirement at the event in which he or she qualifies. This [Priority Status](#) is good for one year and covers all events that are played in that span.

The Priority Status earned from the USKG MEXICO CITY CHAMPIONSHIP based on order of finish, is listed below.

Tournament rounds shortened due to weather, darkness, or other circumstances will not count towards the [scoring requirement](#).
